### SUMMER ENRICHMENT CLASSES

#### Pilot Program 2010

This year Socrates Day School is pleased to introduce a summer pilot program which extends our outstanding U.S. and Greek curricula to the summer. We're ready to take your child on a series of educational adventures that are innovative, stimulating and fun!

Whether your child loves science, geography, history, Greek language studies or drama, we have something to spark his or her imagination. Students will work on a variety of interactive projects both indoors and outdoors (*...it is summer after all!*). Additionally, your child will be in a caring environment that promotes lifelong friendships and core Orthodox values such as respect, integrity, leadership and teamwork.

#### OUR FORMAT

Our Summer Enrichment Program is specifically designed for children ages 7 - 14. Our courses are a minimum of 4 weeks long and offered Monday through Friday. Most courses incorporate separate weekly units on a specific, stand-alone topic. For these courses, students may elect to participate in the entire course or select one or more stand-alone 1-week units. (*Feel free to mix and match weekly units from various programs!*)

All our courses include engaging activities designed to help students think about educational concepts in interesting and fun ways and every course includes lunch.

## OUR 2010 ENRICHMENT COURSES

### Around the World in 20 Days

Be an explorer! Based on Jules Verne's *Around the World in Eighty Days*, this course will explore the customs, cultures, traditions and geography of countries and regions around the world.

4 weeks. Ages 7 - 14 (divided into 2 age groups).



### "Sailing" the Greek Isles

Learn about various Greek islands and their food, dance and traditions while "sailing" the Aegean in this innovative Greek language program.

6 weeks. Ages 7- 10.



## 2010 ENRICHMENT COURSES (cont'd)

### Space Odyssey 2010

Learn about the planets, the Milky Way galaxy, black holes and nebulae. Build your own space robotics too!

4 weeks. Ages 10 - 14.



### Time Traveler: Greece Through Its Art, Myths & Legends

From the ancient theater of Epidaurus to the original Olympic Games, this unique Greek language course travels through time and examines Greece through its art, history, myths and legends. 4 weeks. Ages 10 - 14.



### Shakespearopoulos! English & Greek Drama Workshop

Participate in a production of selections from Shakespeare's famous comedy *A Midsummer Night's Dream* set in a moonlit forest in Athens.

4 weeks. Ages 8 - 14.
