AROUND THE WORLD IN 20 DAYS

Ages: 7 – 14 (divided into 2 age groups)

Duration: June 14 – July 9

Material Fees: \$10 per week

Grab your passport! Grab your suitcase! Join our dynamic Aussie Mrs. Giannetos and fellow student travelers on this exciting trip based on the novel *Around the World in Eighty Days* by Jules Verne. Travel around the world for the whole 4-week course or select the continents you want to experience. Course will include two field trips on the weeks noted. You'll experience the sights, sounds and tastes of some of Greece's most famous islands. From Crete to Rhodes to Santorini– your seat is portside, the sun is strong and the blue Aegean beckons. Don't forget your sunscreen... anchors pull up on June 21 for this 6-week cruise. Join us for all 6 weeks or pick the islands of your choice.

Activities will include:

- Speaking and singing in Greek, playing Greek games and learning Greek dances
- Learning about the customs, traditions and legends of the various islands.
- Arts, crafts and activities (such as building a volcano or castle; cooking regional foods, etc.)

Our intrepid commander Mr. Larson will take our young astronauts on an intergalactic adventure. Learn about the planets, the Milky Way galaxy, black holes and nebulae. Join for the entire 4-week space odyssey or select one or two topics that fuel your rocket! This 4-week class will culminate with the option to join us (with your family) for an intergalactic late night/overnighter at the school. *Details to follow.* Fasten your safety belts, we're ready for blast-off!!

THROUGH ITS ART, MYTHS & LEGENDS (*Greek*)

Students will study selections from *A Midsummer Night's Dream* in both English and Greek and work on set designs. At the conclusion of this 4-week workshop, a performance will be held. Some rehearsals will be conducted outdoors, weather permitting.
